

Western Regional Zone II Paint Horse Show

Vendor Contract

This contract is entered into between the WESTERN REGIONAL ZONE II PAINT HORSE SHOW, WESTERN REGIONAL ZONE II, INC., (hereinafter referred to as WRPHS) and RENO LIVESTOCK EVENTS CENTER (hereinafter referred to as RLEC) and _____ (herein after referred to as the vendor). The parties agree as follows:

1. Booth space is available in 10' x10' increments on the mezzanine for \$85. Outdoor space is available at \$85, with a \$20 per day charge for electricity. All will be payable in advance.
2. Vendor will be liable for and will indemnify and hold harmless WRPHS, and the RLEC from any claim, loss or damages suffered by Vendor, WRPHS, and/or RLEC as a result of any claim, loss or damages occurring to or suffered by any person or company including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing. Vendor, other vendors, WRPHS, and their respective agents, employees, members, and the members of the public attending the show, either on the said space or elsewhere on the RLEC grounds or adjoining premises if said loss or damages arose from or were in any way connected with Vendor's occupancy of said space
3. Vendor agrees to pay for actual cost of repairs for any damage to RLEC [property, including any utility outlet or equipment serving Vendor's booth space, caused by Vendor or Vendor's personnel, occurring during the time Vendor has possession of said space.
4. WRPHS, and/or RLEC shall not be liable in damages or otherwise for failure to carry out the terms of this agreement in whole or in part where caused directly or indirectly by or in consequence of fire, storm, flood, war, rebellion, insurrection, riot, civil commotion, strike or by any cause whatsoever beyond the control of the WRPHS, or RLEC, whether similar to or dissimilar from the causes enumerated herein.
5. WRPHS reserve the right to assign and to alter or change the space assigned to Vendor.
6. Either party may cancel this contract by providing written notice. By canceling this contract after July 15, 2004, Vendor forfeits all rights to his deposit, in addition to all rights and claims to the allocated space and WRPHS is freed to rent it to others. Vendor agrees that this is reasonably related to WRPHS's damages.
7. Vendor, and WRPHS agree that in the event of litigation concerning the contract or the Western Regional Zone II, Inc., the courts of the State of Nevada, Washoe County, shall have sole jurisdiction and that the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorneys' fees.
8. WRPHS reserves the right to cancel this contract and to withhold possession of exhibit space if the Vendor fails to perform any material condition of this contract or refuses to abide by the management's rules and regulations, in which case the Vendor shall forfeit all space rental payments made by him and any further occupancy of such space. Vendor agrees that this is reasonably related to WRPHS's damages.
9. Space contracted to Vendor may not be sublet or assigned without prior written permission of WRPHS.
10. WRPHS assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to goods before, during the period of the show, or after its closing.
11. Vendor agrees to abide by all regulations and rules adopted by WRPHS in the best interests of the show and agrees that WRPHS shall have the right to adopt additional reasonable rules or regulations deemed necessary prior to, during, and after the show.
12. WRPHS reserve the right to expel Vendor and all their personnel if, in the opinion of WRPHS management, Vendor or any of Vendor's personnel become disruptive, boisterous, intoxicated, or participates in any gambling, betting, or lotteries while on RLEC grounds.
13. WRPHS reserves the right at any time to alter or remove exhibits, or any part hereof, including printed materials, products, signs, light, or sound, and to expel Vendor and all their personnel if, in the opinion of WRPHS, their conduct or presentation is objectionable to WRPHS, other vendors, or the general public.

14. All demonstrations and live entertainment must be approved by WRPHS prior to approval of the contract. WRPHS reserves the right to halt any demonstration, which may interfere with fellow vendors or the show. No unnecessary flashing lights or noise will be permitted. No live animals will be allowed without permission.
15. Move-in information: Booths will be open for set-up from 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday. No vehicles will be allowed to drive on the mezzanine while the show is in progress. Electrical hook-ups will be available inside the pavilion at no additional charge. Electrical hook-ups will be available to outside vendors at an additional charge of \$20 per day. Vendor agrees not to dismantle or remove exhibit before 3:00 p.m. on Sunday.
16. Vendor agrees to have exhibit, equipment and appurtenances removed from the RLEC by 10:00a.m. On Monday unless prior arrangements have been made. In the event of failure to do so, Vendor agrees to pay such additional costs as may be incurred.
17. Vendor is responsible for re-crating, preparing bills of lading, and arranging for shipping of all material.
18. WRPHS reserves the right to modify dates and times set forth herein as required by unusual weather, ground conditions or circumstances making changes advisable.
19. Vendors at the Western Regional Paint Horse Show will sell no food or alcoholic beverages.
