APHA will once again sponsor special zone show high-point trophies at each APHA Zone-O-Rama to the high-point winners in the following four divisions — Open, Amateur, Youth & Solid Paint-Bred. Trophies will be awarded according to the rules set forth by the Zone Show Management, but will be awarded to members from that zone.

Open and Solid Paint Bred Divisions:

- a. The horse owner must reside in your zone.
- b. The horse owner must be a current member of APHA, in good standing.
- c. Open and Solid Paint Bred awards are calculated per horse.

Amateur & Youth Divisions:

- a. The Amateur/Youth exhibitor must reside in your zone.
- b. The Amateur/Youth exhibitor and horse owner must be a current member of APHA, in good standing.
- c. Amateur and Youth awards are calculated per horse and exhibitor combination.

APHA GELDING PLUS

- ◆ Owner must be a current APHA member in good standing
- ◆ Owner must reside in the Zone 2 region
- ◆ Horses are only eligible to win one division per three years (horses who won any gelding plus money in 2007 will not be eligible again until 2010)
- ◆ Horse must be a Regular Registry

Gelding Plus FAQ

Do geldings need to be registered as a gelding prior to their 3 year old year to be eligible?

As long as the horse is a gelding on file with APHA prior to competition, he is eligible for the current Gelding Plus Program.

Does my gelding need to have the Gelding Plus emblem on his certificate to be eligible?

No, as long as your horse is a gelding on file with APHA, he is eligible.

If my horse is a gelding but listed as a stallion with APHA, how do I get that changed?

Send in the original certificate to APHA and a completed Affidavit for Corrected Certificate along with the \$20 fee and the corrected papers will be sent to you shortly.
